Please make sure to download the MMTTC Course Catalog, which outlines the entire course, tuition and admission procedure. **The next opportunity for enrollment will begin on Wednesday September 5, 2018 at 4pm, with the class “Montessori Practical Life & Sensorial.”** Enrollment for this class closes Friday, August 31, 2018.

The MMTTC has approval to operate by the State of California, and is accredited by the Montessori Accreditation Council for Teacher Education (MACTE), who oversees Montessori training centers across the country. We are affiliated with PAMS (Pan American Montessori Society) and we offer 24 transferable college units for the training through CSU East Bay Extension. The MMTTC Co-Director, Rebecca Keith, has been teaching for over 40 years and has been training teachers through the MMTTC since 1981. This is truly an exceptional program!

We hope that you will take the time to review the course catalog in detail, and consider the MMTTC for your Montessori training. We offer small group classes, flexibility with payment options and a training schedule that allows you to work while you learn. If you are accepted into the program, you will be sent a letter of acceptance and a financial contract. To complete your enrollment in the program, you need to return the financial contract to us with the first tuition installment. In the instance that you are not accepted into the program, you will be notified. Please do not let the amount of tuition keep you from pursuing your Montessori Certification. We would be happy to discuss your needs and create a payment plan that works for you.
